*\*The following items are required to properly train to course standards and within prescribed safety requirements*

Precision rifle platform; quality bolt action rifle or purpose built AR Platform <i>*with low bi-pod</i>	1	
Tactical / target rifle scope; should have "exposed" turrets and target / milling - tactical reticle	1	
80 rounds of match grade ammunition per course / 160 for both courses <i>*no steel core or penetrator</i>	80 rounds per course	
Shooting Sticks / Tripod / Stabilization Aides	shooter's choice	
Tactical / Competition Rifle Sling	shooter's choice	
*Spare magazines for AR platforms as well as bolt guns with detachable box mags (DBM)	2	
Weapons case for transportation and storage on the range	1	
Allen wrenches / required tool to "slip" scope turrets after zeroing rifle & torque screws to spec	1	
Caliber specific weapons cleaning kit w/ solvents and patches	1	
Sand sock /stabilization bag / rear bags	2	
Appropriate Range Clothing; *please check the weather forecast and dress appropriately	1	
Rain gear top and bottoms; we will train in the rain, sleet or snow	1 set	
Warming layers; fleece jacket, sweatshirt, underarmor long sleeve shirt, etc... <i>*seasonal</i>	1 each	
Stocking cap / Fleece cap / neck gaiter <i>*seasonal</i>	1	
Headgear; brimmed hat or tactical ball cap	1	
Gloves	1	
Bug repellent; <i>*seasonal</i>	1	
<i>* Ballistic Eyewear / Sunglasses; should be shatter proof / ballistic quality or legitimate protective eye wear</i>	1	
Hearing protection; foam ear plugs or hearing muffs are acceptable	1
